**Prize money:** 1<sup>st</sup> \$30 (min 3 entries) 2<sup>nd</sup> \$20 (min 4 entries) 3<sup>rd</sup> \$10 (min 5 entries)

**Champion and Reserve Champion Sashes awarded for:**

CU Prep (1 & 2), CU Prelim (3 & 4), CU Novice (5 & 6), OC Prelim (7 & 8), OC Novice (9 & 10), OC Elem (11 & 12), OC Medium (13 & 14), OC Advanced (15 & 16), OC Small Tour (17 & 18), OC Big Tour (19 & 20) – riders must compete in both classes to be eligible for championship

**Note:** For the purpose of deciding a Champion at a level (EA rule 3.19) points are awarded from first to last horse and Champion is the horse with the highest combined points of the two tests. In the event of a tie, Champion will be the horse with highest aggregate percentage at that level. If a further tie, horse with the highest percentage in the higher test in that level will be the winner.

#### Conditions of entry

- **CU: Riders must be Grafton Riding Club or Equestrian Australia (EA) Members**
- **OC: Horses and Riders must be registered EA**
- **ENTRY to the grounds will be via HAY Street, Minden Street gate will be closed.**
- The event will be run in strict accordance with EA rules [www.equestrian.org.au](http://www.equestrian.org.au)
- **Preparatory - \*- means you must not of previously won at this level or at a higher level**
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times
- Horses may only compete in two consecutive levels and may not do any more than 3 tests on the day
- Draw will be posted on nominate
- You may enter no more than two horses on the day
- Saddlery and dress – please refer to EA rules with exception no jacket required and T-Shirt may be worn
- Camping is for up to 4 people per site
- Undercover yards/stalls available bring your own bedding
- In the event of scratching, a Vet or Doctor's certificate must be produced within 7 days of the conclusion of the event in order to receive a refund. Please note GRC will retain administration fee if the event is cancelled
- Camping is available on Saturday night prior to official comp at \$22 per site (for up to 4 people)
- When departing gates to yards and/stables must be closed.
