Conditions of entry

- **You must be a member of the EA, Grafton Riding Club or the Pony Club to compete or ride on the grounds.**
- **ENTRY to the grounds will be via HAY Street, Minden Street gate will be closed from 7am on Sunday.**
- **Preparatory *** means horse and rider combination must not have won or placed previously in a test at Novice level or higher.
- The event will be run in accordance with EA dressage rules www.equestrian.org.au
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Horses can compete in two consecutive levels (i.e.Prep/Prelim) and can enter in up to THREE tests on the day.
- Draw and results will be posted on Nominate.
- You may enter no more than two horses on the day – 50mins will be allowed between each horses tests where this is possible.
- Saddlery and dress – please refer to EA rules, with exception that no jacket is required and a T-Shirt may be worn.
- Camping is available on Sat night prior and is for up to 4 people per site please book via Nominate with your entry.
- Undercover yards/stalls available bring your own bedding.
- In the event of scratching, a Vet or Doctor's certificate must be produced within 7 days of the conclusion of the event in order to receive a refund. Please note GRC will retain administration fee if the event is cancelled.
- When departing venue gates to yards and/stables must be closed.
- Plaiting is not necessary.
- Judges may not be EA accredited.
- EA Bridle numbers are not required.
- **GEAR CHECK - Changed EA Rule 4.4:** You must report to the Steward for a Gear Check **immediately after each test.** If you are uncertain about the gear you are using you are also most welcome to ask the Gear Steward before your class.
- **NOTE RE ACCIDENTS OR INCIDENTS:** EA requires that all accidents and incidents are recorded and reported. Competitors are reminded that they need to report to the Organising Committee including any incidents deemed 'near misses'.
